*FACTS Grant & Aid Application will be used to determine eligibility for FIT (Family Individualized Tuition), ACE Scholarships, & Additional SCES Scholarships. To be eligible for consideration for Grant & Aid, families must apply and submit ALL requested documentation. Packet must be marked **COMPLETE** in FACTS by the deadline on April 15, 2024.*

GRANT & AID (2023-2024)

Applications Open February 6 – April 18, 2023

St. Cyprian's Episcopal School utilizes the secure online service of FACTS Grant & Aid to process financial aid applications. With one application and a single application fee, families can apply for multiple financial aid opportunities at SCES.

GRANT & AID APPLICATION PROCESS

- PREPARE TO APPLY** Collect the required supporting documents: W-2 forms for all jobs; most recently filed tax return (1040, 1040A, 1040EZ with all schedules), most recently filed Business Tax return if applicable, and any supplemental income documentation (social security, welfare, food stamps, child support, 1099M forms, workers compensation, unemployment, veteran's benefits, etc.).
- APPLY FOR GRANT & AID** in your FACTS Family Account or Application for Enrollment. Complete the required information and submit the required documentation. There is a \$40 application fee per family that should be paid to FACTS Grant & Aid. (Note: If you would like to be considered for the ACE Scholarship you must select the box noting you are applying for ACE.) Any application that is not marked COMPLETE in the system will not be considered for award. Timely submission and uploading requested documentation are important.
- AWARD NOTIFICATION** Scholarship award decisions are made per student (not per family) and will be made after the application closes. Once your information is processed, SCES will receive a recommendation from FACTS, and that recommendation will be reviewed by our Grant & Aid Committee. Families will be notified of awards in May/June.

FIT (Family Individualized Tuition)

Every St. Cyprian's family has a significant stake in their child's education. Our FIT program allows each family to have a personalized tuition based on their unique circumstances. Families may choose to pay the full tuition rate or submit FACTS Grant & Aid application to receive a personalized FIT. Fairness and confidentiality are at the heart of this process. New families are required to submit their Application for Admission prior to receiving their FIT plan.

What is my Fit? Fit can reduce the full tuition rate up to 40% off. Families who are low income may be eligible for additional scholarship if funding is available.

The deadline for Grant & Aid is April 18, 2023, for the 2023-2024 School Year. We do continue to accept and review applications for FIT after the deadline if funds are available. Scholarships have a hard deadline of April 18.

SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM

SCES has partnered with two K-12 scholarships program that are both dedicated to providing scholarships that are purely needs-based for families who meet the income qualifications. To see if your family would qualify for a scholarship, please see the chart below.
